## Executive summary

## 1. Introduction

AgrEcoMed is a 36-month Research and Innovation Action (RIA) project under Grant Agreement No PRIMA21\_00018 aiming to fill the research gaps for implementing a biodiversity-based strategy for primary crops as cereal farming systems through an Agroecological approach adapted to environments in Mediterranean countries, efficient use of natural resources, reduction of pollution, circular economy. The effective start of the project is 23/05/2022 and the project ends 36 months later, on 31/05/2025. The AgrEcoMed consortium consists of 8 partners from 4 countries (including two EU and non-EU countries). The project is coordinated by the University of Basilicata (UNIBAS, Italy). The project has an overall budget of 1,308,051.15 €. The budget detailed per beneficiary and the corresponding EU contribution of each beneficiary is detailed in Annex 2 to the Grant Agreement – Estimated budget of the action. The contact database is divided into public administrations, NGOs, and farms. It builds a database of contacts which will be used to involve them in different activities of the project. These databases will be used for keeping all of them updated on the project progresses and will be segmented facilitating the tailoring and dissemination of messages to each target group.
